

How to indicate the corresponding author in your CR paper

There are two solutions:

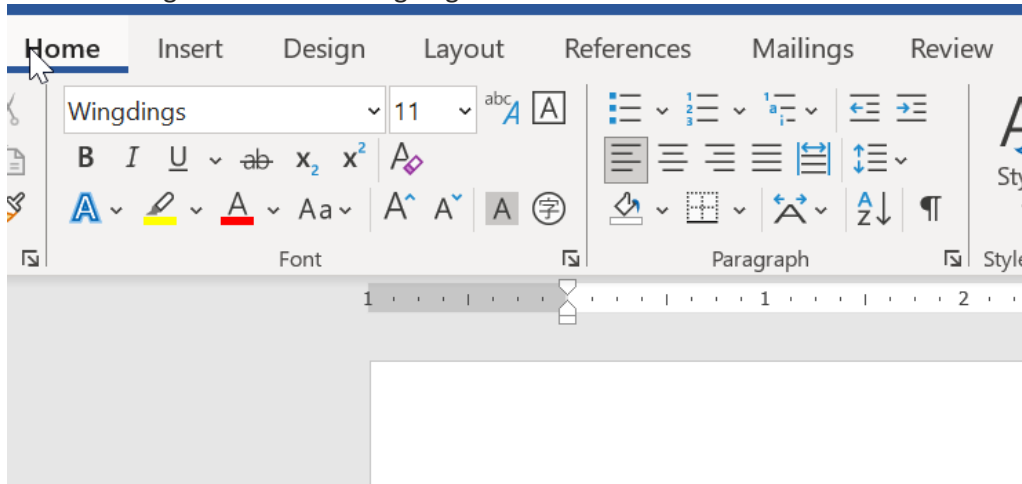
1. Add an envelope symbol next to the corresponding author, as shown in the figure below.
2. Add a footnote to indicate the corresponding author.

The first solution is preferred by Springer.

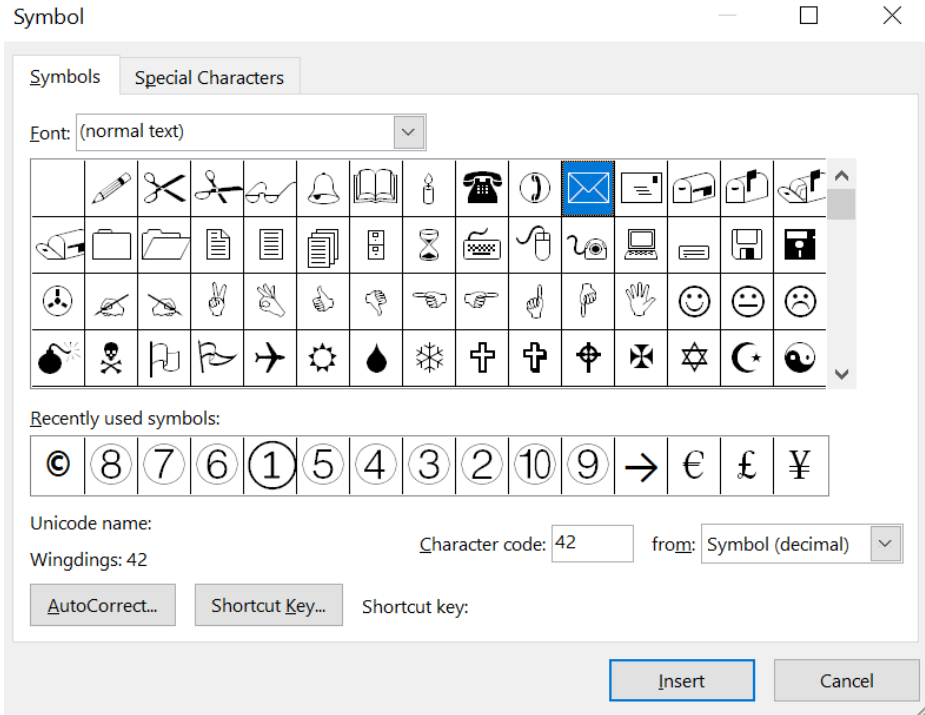


Steps to add the envelop simple in **Word**:

1. Change the font as "Wingdings"



2. "Insert" -> "Symbol" -> "More Symbols...", and you will find the little "envelop".



Steps to add the envelop simple in **Latex**:

Please kindly find attached the steps of how to indicate the corresponding author in your CR version.

We would like also to remind you with the CR paper and registration deadline: 20 September (strict deadline).

Please make also sure that the CR version passes the similarity check (less than 15-20%), as all papers will be checked by Springer during the publication phase, to avoid delaying the publication of your paper. Springer did not provide us with an access to similarity check, so please do it on your own, if you can.
